A new day at Fulton First UMC has begun. After a long period of reflection, we have chosen to move forward with the Annie Ruth Pirtle Childcare Center. We have already received calls about being on a waiting list! How amazing is God?

I am sure you are wondering what the next steps are. First, the Childcare Team and the Trustees are finalizing the building plans to be sent to the state for approval. Once that step is complete, the plans will be sent to several construction firms for bids. When the bids are back the Trustees will review and a proposal will be prepared for the Finance Team. When those groups have agreed it will be voted on by the Church Council.

Secondly, we have been blessed to receive a matching fund challenge of \$50,000 for the Annie Ruth Pirtle Childcare Center. The Childcare Team and the Finance Team are finalizing a plan to invite your support. You will be receiving a letter, as will many of our community partners, to prayerfully consider helping fund the construction of the Center. Partner sponsor levels are being developed now, and pledge information sent with the appropriate letter.

Finally, the Childcare Team can now begin to work on the operational details of the Annie Ruth Pirtle Childcare Center. They will set hours the center will be open, student population ratios, staff expectations, and afterschool program structure. A parent handbook, teacher handbook, training schedule, and a business plan will be developed and presented to our Church Council in cooperation with partner teams SPPRC, Trustees, Finance, Discipleship, and Mission and Outreach. There is a lot of work ahead, but it is exciting work and it's a gift to be able to watch God work in our church and community.

That's not the only news though. Casey Jones has stepped up to Music Director and is working hard to get oriented into planning worship on Fridays for Celebrate Recovery and two worship services on Sundays. She is doing well and will be helping us develop music opportunities. Todd Belt is our new Media and Communications Director. He is learning all our existing ways of communicating and is trying to help us be more effective. If you have ideas or suggestions, you will want to share them with Todd. 

Railroader Taco Bar – We will feed the Railroaders Monday, 6/3/2024 at 5:30pm. Everyone is invited. Mark your calendar!


# A Note from Associate Pastor
